E.g. *was not* becomes *wasn't*  
*did not*, *is not*, *should have*,  
*could not*, *he is*, *they are*, *we are*
- ✓ Write a character description of your favourite superhero.
- ✓ Write an example of each of these sentence types:
  - Exclamation
  - Command
  - Question
  - Statement
- ✓ In a story would you rather be a superhero or a supervillain? Explain why.
- ✓ Can you make your own superhero comic? You can make it about a well-known superhero or make up a superhero of your own!

### MATHS CHALLENGES



- ✓ Practise writing numbers 1 - 20 as words. e.g. *one*, *two*, *three* etc.
- ✓ Has half of this shape been coloured in? Explain your answer.  

- ✓ Which is more?
  - $\frac{1}{2}$  of 10
  - $\frac{1}{4}$  of 12Explain your answer.
- ✓ If you have 12 counters, how many ways can you divide them into equal groups?
- ✓ What is:
  - $\frac{1}{2}$  of 12
  - $\frac{1}{4}$  of 12
  - $\frac{1}{2}$  of 20
  - $\frac{1}{4}$  of 20

- ✓ Create a picture in the style of the famous artist Roy Lichtenstein.  

- ✓ Design your own superhero outfit.
