



Knowledge Organisers



At Stanley Green we have changed the way that we deliver our teaching for our afternoon topics. Instead of teaching many subjects throughout the half term, we now have a whole school focus. This enables pupils to deepen and embed knowledge for long-term memory and build on previously taught skills. This year our afternoon focuses look like this:

Knowledge gained throughout each topic is revisited throughout the year within our whole school Values afternoons, our assemblies, and in our Flashback Friday sessions. Flashback Friday afternoons are a fun interactive 20 minute session where teachers revisit past learning. Children will be asked quiz style questions to help embed knowledge into their long - term memory. Flashback Friday's will also focus on English and Maths skills taught in previous weeks.

In order to support your child with Flashback Friday's, we have developed our own Knowledge Organisers to support the delivery of the curriculum. Each Knowledge Organiser starts with knowledge children should already know from previous learning and identifies the key information that children need to have learned by the end of a topic. It also acts as a tool to support children in retaining and retrieving knowledge for life-long learning.
